

1. Disassembly

- a. Remove and retain the outer 3-2 downshift valve lineup (reverse abuse) or low overrun valve lineup (forward abuse).
- b. Remove rolled spring pin and save for reuse. Remove abuse bore plug and discard.
- c. Remove and discard forward or reverse abuse valve and spring.
- d. If reaming the reverse bore, remove the solenoid immediately adjacent to the bore.

2. Bore Reaming

Ream forward or reverse abuse bore (for reaming instructions/reamer care, please visit www.sonnax.com). Sonnax reaming tool kit **F-77754-TL58** and **VB-FIX** are required for this operation.

3. Installation & Assembly

- a. Be certain all debris has been removed from the valve bore and valve body.
- b. Install Sonnax valve and spring, refering to main photo for proper orientation and alignment.

NOTE: The Sonnax valve and spring work in either the forward or reverse abuse locations.

- c. Install Sonnax bore plug and retain with OE pin.
- d. Reinstall OE 3-2 downshift valve lineup (reverse abuse) or low overrun valve lineup (forward abuse).

4. Final Testing

Vacuum testing at the port(s) indicated holds the recommended minimum 18 in-Hg.
